TODAY'S SERMON

Pastor Tom Continuing in "The Way of Righteousness"

"The Prophet Zechariah"

"Rejoice greatly, O Daughter of Zion! Shout, Daughter of Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and having salvation, gentle and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey." Zechariah 9:9 The Book of Zechariah teaches that salvation may be obtained by all. God desires that all people worship Him and accepts those who do, regardless of their national or political expressions. Zechariah preached that God is sovereign over this world; God sees all that will happen.

God does not eliminate the individual's freedom to follow Him or rebel, but holds people responsible for the choices they make.

God expects sincere worship and moral living of us today. We must extend God's invitation of salvation to people of all national origins, languages, races, and cultures. Salvation is only available through the shed blood of Jesus Christ on the cross, who died in our place to atone for sin. If we reject that sacrifice, there is no other sacrifice through which we can be reconciled to God.

There is no other name under heaven by which men are saved (<u>Acts 4:12</u>). There is no time to lose; today is the day of salvation (<u>2 Corinthians 6:2</u>)
