This is **Mary**. She is a Kuy tribeswoman from Preah Vihear province in kingdom of Cambodia. She came to the Student Residence & Discipling Centre (SR&DC) in February 2023. She studies History at the Royal University of Phnom Penh. When Mën got a good job in her home province, Mary was chosen to replace her as Dorm Leader. We ask you dear friends and family to pray that this young lady will become a powerful woman of God, and that she will be a remarkable leader of our sixteen female residents.

Our middle child, Stéphanie is in dire need or a touch from the Great Physician. She suffers from Guillain–Barré Syndrome. This dreadful disease causes her immune system to attack her nerves. She was hospitalized but is now at home. She is barely able to walk, and it is next to impossible to properly care for her husband and four children (the youngest is one). Pray she will be delivered.

We have had several vision teams come to Cambodia in the last while. It was a pleasure to welcome them to visit the SR&DC. A couple times we heard a

testimony from them before a Discipling lesson was taught. At our last Outreach event, the pastor from New Jerusalem Church brought a devotional. When he left, he echoed a theme that the visiting teams had mentioned. They all sensed a strong Spirit of the Living God. Pray that this will only become stronger as the young ladies go deeper in the Word each week. They request prayer for their unsaved relatives back in their villages.



While we were on Home Assignment last year, we asked you to pray that Srey Leap (left) and Kanha would accept Jesus. It is with great pleasure that I can announce that they have done so. Both took their time to be sure this was what they wanted to do for the rest of their lives. God is on the move.

At the beginning of March we attended the Global Gathering. All the missionaries of The Alliance in Canada assembled in Chiang Mai, Thailand for a spectacular time of refreshing and renewal. We were blessed with several messages from Dr. Stanley John and multiple thrilling presentations.
